Jesus is King

John 12:12-13 The next day a great crowd who had come to Jerusalem for the Passover Feast heard that Jesus was coming there. ¹³ So they took branches of palm trees and went out to meet Jesus, shouting, "Praise God! God bless the One who comes in the name of the Lord! God bless the King of Israel!"

1 Corinthians 15:55-57 "Death, where is your victory? Death, where is your pain?" ⁵⁶ Death's power to hurt is sin, and the power of sin is the law. ⁵⁷ But we thank God! He gives us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ.

Zechariah 9:9 Rejoice greatly, people of Jerusalem! Shout for joy, people of Jerusalem! Your king is coming to you. He does what is right, and he saves. He is gentle and riding on a donkey, on the colt of a donkey.

Psalms 118:26 God bless the one who comes in the name of the Lord. We bless all of you from the Temple of the Lord.

Luke 19:41-42 As Jesus came near Jerusalem, he saw the city and cried for it, ⁴² saying, "I wish you knew today what would bring you peace. But now it is hidden from you.

Luke 23:20-21 Pilate wanted to let Jesus go free and told this to the crowd. ²¹ But they shouted again, "Crucify him! Crucify him!"

John 18:33 Then Pilate went back inside the palace and called Jesus to him and asked, "Are you the king of the Jews?"

John 18:36 Jesus answered, "My kingdom does not belong to this world. If it belonged to this world, my servants would have fought to keep me from being given over to the Jewish leaders. But my kingdom is from another place."

John 3:16 God loved the world so much that he gave his one and only Son so that whoever believes in him may not be lost, but have eternal life.

Revelation 7:9-10 After the vision of these things I looked, and there was a great number of people, so many that no one could count them. They were from every nation, tribe, people, and language of the earth.
