November 24, 2024 Give Thanks to God in Everything

- Ephesians 5:20 Always give thanks to God the Father for everything, in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ.
- Luke 17:11-16 While Jesus was on his way to Jerusalem, he was going through the area between Samaria and Galilee. ¹² As he came into a small town, ten men who had a skin disease met him there. They did not come close to Jesus ¹³ but called to him, "Jesus! Master! Have mercy on us!" ¹⁴ When Jesus saw the men, he said, "Go and show yourselves to the priests." As the ten men were going, they were healed. ¹⁵ When one of them saw that he was healed, he went back to Jesus, praising God in a loud voice. ¹⁶ Then he bowed down at Jesus' feet and thanked him. (And this man was a Samaritan.)
- Philippians 4:12 I know how to live when I am poor, and I know how to live when I have plenty. I have learned the secret of being happy at any time in everything that happens, when I have enough to eat and when I go hungry, when I have more than I need and when I do not have enough.
- 1 Corinthians 1:4 I always thank my God for you because of the grace God has given you in Christ Jesus.
- Daniel 6:10 Even though Daniel knew that the new law had been written, he went to pray in an upstairs room in his house, which had windows that opened toward Jerusalem. Three times each day Daniel would kneel down to pray and thank God, just as he always had done.
- 1 Thessalonians 5:18 and give thanks whatever happens. That is what God wants for you in Christ Jesus.
