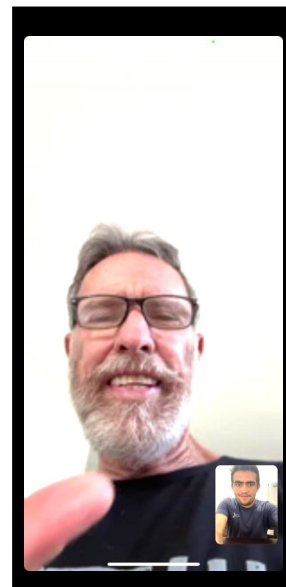


Greetings,
