Greetings in the Name of Jesus Christ, our Lord!

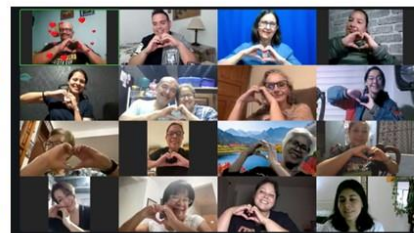
"He said to them, 'Go into all the world and preach the gospel to all creation.'" Mark 16:15.

On August 20th, I taught the Deaf people these scriptures on Zoom and explained who Jesus' 12 disciples/apostles were and what they did in their missions. Then at the closure, I told them that we were so grateful to God and were so proud of them for they didn't stop sharing the Good News and continue to teach their own people in Mexico after we returned to the USA in 2000. They are faithful in serving the Lord and using the Zoom since most of them do not have the church at their homes. They live in everywhere in Mexico. Only few do have their church such as in Mexico City, Jojutla, and Guadalajara, Even, some Deaf believers who join us the Bible study on Zoom are from Columbia, Chile, and USA.

Linda has been emailing the monthly devotions to the Deaf people since the year of 2000 after we returned to USA.

We and the pastors/teachers in turn teach the Bible on Zoom every Tuesday and Thursday at 8:00 pm here (9:00 pm there) for almost 4 years. Average number of attendees is between 26 and 32. Image that 4 to 8 people are having their prayer meetings on Zoom every morning at 5:30 am there. Wow! Blessing them as they are so hungry for the Word of God and have their love for Him..
