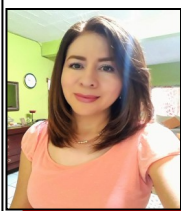
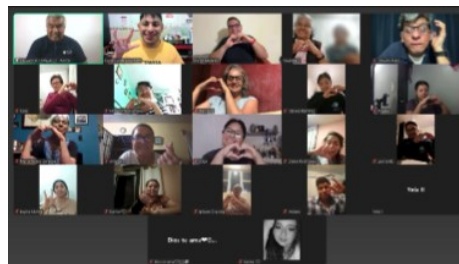
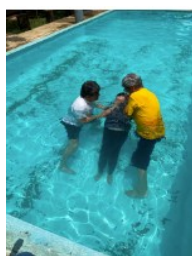
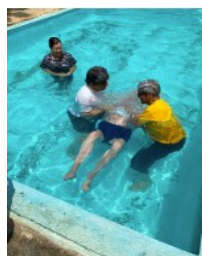


Pastor Asael and Teresa Caneda (South Mexico City)
